BODY OF REPORT:

ON 2/10/08 I WAS PARTNERS WITH SGT. JAMESON #1337. AT APPROXIMATELY 1645 HOURS WE MADE CONTACT WITH VI LAWS WHO HAD DRIVEN TO THE STATION, 3112 N. GRAND BLVD. TO REPORT DOMESTIC ABUSE.

VI LAWS ADVISED THAT HER HUSBAND OF ONE YEAR, LATER TO BE IDENTIFIED AS AR LAWS, HAD GOTTEN UPSET ABOUT SOME PANCAKES VI LAWS HAD FIXED AND BEGAN TO GET VERBALLY AND PHYSICALLY ABUSIVE. THE AR WAS VERY UPSET AND GRABBED VI LAWS AROUND HER NECK AND THREW HER TO THE FLOOR. SHE GOT UP AND HE THREW HER ONTO THE BED IN THE BEDROOM AND GOT ON TOP OF HER. THE AR BEGAN TO HIT VI LAWS IN

THE FACE WITH HIS OPEN PALM NUMEROUS TIMES. AFTER HITTING HER IN THE FACE, AR LAWS PLACED HIS HANDS AROUND VI [REDACTED] NECK AND BEGAN TO STRANGLE HER. VI LAWS STATED THAT HER AIRWAY WAS CONSTRICTED AND SHE HAD TROUBLE BREATHING AT LEAST ONE TIME DURING THE ALTERCATION. AR LAWS EVENTUALLY RAISED UP OFF OF VI [REDACTED] THE ENTIRE ALTERCATION OCCURRED IN FRONT OF VI [REDACTED] TWO CHILDREN, WI [REDACTED] AND WI [REDACTED] BOTH CHILDREN WERE VERY UPSET. VI [REDACTED] TOOK HER CHILDREN AND LEFT THE SCENE BECAUSE SHE THOUGHT THE AR MAY GET MAD AND ATTACK HER AGAIN. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE ALTERCATION OCCURRED ON THIS DATE AT APPROXIMATELY 1200 HOURS.

VI [REDACTED] THEN ADVISED THAT SHE PICKED UP HER FRIEND AND DROVE AROUND IN AN ATTEMPT TO GET HER THOUGHTS TOGETHER. SHE DECIDED TO REPORT THE ALTERCATION AND SHE DROVE TO THE WILL ROGERS BRIEFING STATION.

I OBSERVED A RED MARK ON VI [REDACTED] RIGHT CHEEK AND NUMEROUS RED MARKS AROUND HER NECK AND COLLARBONE AREA. I ALSO OBSERVED A FRESH BRUISE ON VI LAWS RIGHT HAND. LT. DAWSON #1029 CAME OUT AND TOOK PICTURES OF THE VISIBLE INJURIES.

AT THIS TIME VI [REDACTED] AGREED TO SIGN AN ASSAULT AND BATTERY CITATION ON THE AR. VI [REDACTED] TOLD ME THAT SHE BELIEVED THE AR WAS STILL AT HOME. MY PARTNER AND I ALONG WITH OFFICER BROWN #1548 WENT TO THE ABOVE LOCATION TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE AR. AR LAWS WAS AT THE RESIDENCE AND I PLACED HIM UNDER ARREST FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE BY STRANGULATION. I RAN AR LAWS THROUGH CIU AND IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT HE HAD THE ABOVE LISTED WARRANTS AS WELL.

FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL PARTIES INVOLVED, I TOOK CUSTODY OF THE ABOVE LISTED FIREARMS. I CHECKED THEM BOTH THROUGH CIU.

I TRANSPORTED AR LAWS TO THE OKLAHOMA COUNTY JAIL WHERE HE WAS BOOKED IN ON THE ABOVE LISTED CHARGES WITHOUT INCIDENT. I BOOKED THE FIREARMS INTO THE OCPD PROPERTY ROOM UNDER THIS CASE NUMBER.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT LT. DAWSON AUTHORIZED THE HOLD FOR STATE CHARGES.
